DAY #1: We will depart St. Louis this morning and head into Tennessee. We will check into our accommodations in Clarksville, TN for the next three nights! This evening we will enjoy a delicious barbecue dinner and be entertained by the fabulous bluegrass band, Passenger Creek, performing old time southern gospel songs and more!

DAY #2: This morning enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then we will enjoy a driving tour of historic Clarksville. After, our short journey will bring us into Bon Aqua, TN for a visit to Johnny Cash's Storyteller Farm. Johnny called his farm "the center of his universe." Hear stories about Johnny from his nephew, Mark Alan Cash, as he sings tributes to his Uncle Johnny. We will also have an included lunch at the farm. This afternoon we head west to Loretta Lynn's ranch for an included tour of the Coal Miner's Daughter Museum. Free time will be given to tour additional attractions in Western Town and to visit the shops and galleries. Tonight's dinner will be served at the amphitheater at Loretta Lynn's Ranch. After dinner, relax and enjoy gospel music with a country twist! Listen and toe tap to some wonderful music and fellowship with Ken Mellons - who had hits like Jukebox Junkie and Rub a dubbin' in My Tub, followed by Jeff Bates, who had hits on the country charts in the early 2000's.

DAY #3: Today we will head out to Historic Collinsville in rural Montgomery County. This 40 acre pioneer settlement tells the story of life from 1840 - 1900. These 16 log buildings are full of true to time period antiques and are a delight to all who visit. We regularly hear that the attraction sparks memories of a time visiting grandparents on the family farm. Savor the delicious included old time "luncheon on the grounds" with music by Southern gospel quartet, Still Water. After lunch we will head back to Clarksville for a shopping stop at Miss Lucille's Marketplace. Best described as "where Pinterest meets Etsy", this marketplace features antiques, handmade, recycled and repurposed treasures. In addition to the shopping experience, they have a lovely café for a cup of coffee or a sweet treat. After a short rest at the hotel, we will have dinner at a local venue and music by Grammy and Dove award winner, Jason Crabb. Crabb's electrifying stage presence, powerhouse gospel vocals and magnetic personality have endeared him to millions across the world.
